OSHAKATI TOWN COUNCIL HOSTS ITS ANNUAL BUSINESS BREAKFAST



Oshakati Town Council successfully hosted its annual Business Breakfast on the 19th February 2021 at Oshakati Guest House. This year's Business Breakfast was aimed at engaging the business community of Oshakati in the topic discussion "Economic revival during and after COVID19." The event was officiated by Mr. Martin Inkumbi the Chief Executive Officer of Development Bank of Namibia (DBN). The event was well attended by the business fraternity of Oshakati. The annual Business Breakfast also serves as a platform to share concerns and ideas on the town's development.

DISCONNECTION OF WATER ACCOUNTS

Oshakati Town Council is hereby requesting all residents of Oshakati, Businesses and Institutions who have outstanding municipal accounts to settle their bills. The deadline for settling of all outstanding municipal accounts is always on the 07th of every month and accounts that are not paid on the due date, will be disconnected. The disconnection of water accounts begun on the 1st April 2021 for all the residential, business and institutions that are in arrears. Residents should note that there is no re-connection of water accounts after hours and are urged to ensure that their payments are done before 16H00 each day to avoid any inconvenience. A payment agreement can be entered into between the client and Oshakati Town Council, provided that the client pays 50% of the outstanding amount. Payments can be done at the Oshakati Town Council cashier halls at the head office or via Eft.

FORMALIZATION OF UUPINDI LOCATION



Oshakati Town Council has commenced with Phase one of the formalization of Uupindi South Phase 1. Council held a meeting with the residents of Uupindi South on the 1st and 2nd February 2021, to get inputs from the community of Uupindi South location to be incorporated in the layout plan as part of the formalization process.

As part of creating conducive living environment for the residents of Oshakati, it is imperative to ensure that residents have access to municipal services such as water, sewerage lines, electricity, and roads access. For the residents to acquire these services, informal setlements need to be formalized. Currently Oshoopala location have already been proclaimed and formalized, while Oneshila, Okandjengedi, Pohamba and Evululuko location are in the process of being formalized.

UPGRADING OF THE OSHAKATI CARIBBEAN FACILITY



Oshakati Town Council has commenced with Phase Two (2) of the revamping of the Caribbean recreational facility. Phase Two consist of the revamping of the restaurant, toilets, changing rooms and the payment rooms. The work is expected to be complete by end of April 2021. Phase Three (3) will consist of the revamping of the sports arena such as the tennis, netball, basketball and volleyball courts. Last year Council completed the Phase One (1) of the revamping, of the facility, which mainly consisted of putting up a swimming pool for children and revamping the existing swimming pool for adults. Once this facility is complete, it will be able to cater for various fun activities and sports events.
