SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Oshakati Town Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing, and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

Bidders are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be **90 days** from the date of bid submission deadline.

If a bidder has already lodged a submission, it may revise that submission and resubmit it no later than the extended submission closing time.

11. Addenda

Oshakati Town Council may, from time to time, clarify any aspects of the RFQ documentation, which require clarification and will issue addenda to all bidders detailing such clarifications.

12. Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration

17. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. 18. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared

based on evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

19. Technical Compliance

20. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits, and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.
